The Core Theatre Solihull is part of The Core building in Theatre Square, Touchwood. Theatre Square is reached either from Touchwood, or by a walkway from Homer Road, up the side of The Core building. The nearest car park is Touchwood - the 'Orange zone' will bring you up near the glass doors to Theatre Square. Taxi drop-off is not free - a minimum charge applies.

High sided vehicles cannot enter Touchwood and should drop off/park elsewhere. The postcode for Touchwood car park is B91 3GJ. Solihull Station is a 5 minute walk away and bus and rail services run regularly to/from Birmingham and other areas. More information on how to get here is available on our website.

Box Office & Tickets

Opening hours are currently 9.30am - 2.30pm Mon - Fri (10am start on Wed) subject to change - see website. The counter reopens 90 minutes before a main theatre show starts, except film nights when tickets are sold at Encore bar.

Access

The main theatre auditorium has raked seating with two aisles. There are no handrails down the aisles but we have fitted 'grab rails' at each end of seat rows to assist and support audiences whilst using the stairs.

Rows A-G are best approached from ground floor entrance - Rows H-P are accessed via a staircase of 24 steps or lift. Access is provided via the Core passenger lift (suitable for wheelchairs) which is a glass lift located in the foyer on the right hand side of the main doors. This takes you up to the first floor within easy walking distance of the theatre entrance on the upper level, making the back of the Theatre accessible to all (except wheelchair users who cannot transfer).

Front row seats are at ground level and are reserved for those with mobility or access needs until the rest of the auditorium is approaching sell-out. Please call Box Office with your ticket requirements and make known any concerns or needs you may have at the point of booking.

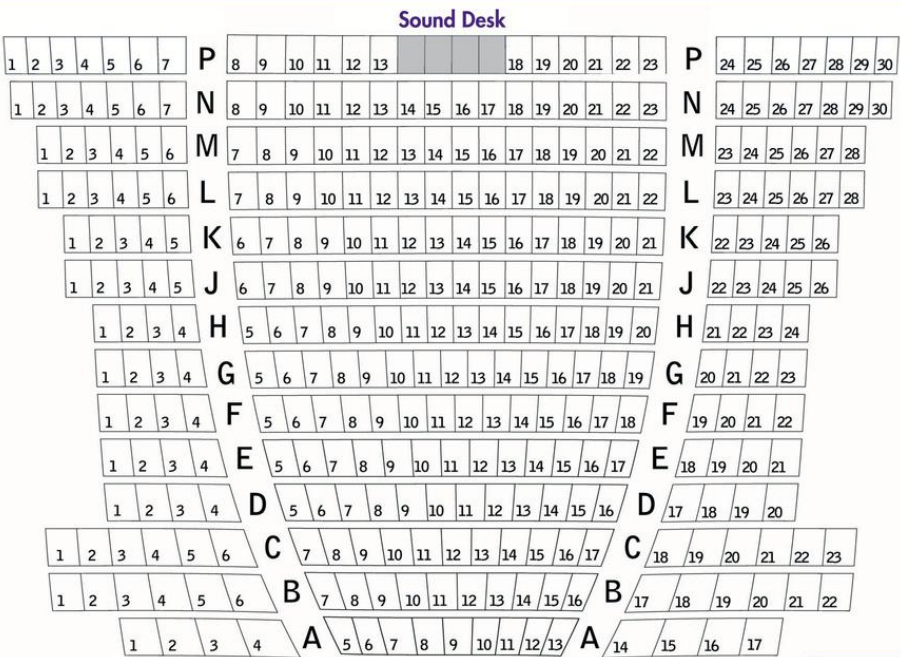
Staff will advise and assist you to obtain the best possible seating to ensure your visit is both accessible and enjoyable.

The Studio is a multi-use performance area located on the ground floor just off the foyer and Encore café bar. Access is flat with double-width entry doors.

There are wheelchair accessible toilet facilities on ground floor (left of Encore café bar) and first floor (near the Upper Floor Theatre entrance). There are baby changing facilities on the ground floor and also in the Children's Library.
